Guest Speaker Last Meeting

Brent Lamkin & Randy Jordan updated us on the Lubbock County Expo Center. Progress continues in the development, planning, and fundraising for this multi-million-dollar center. Revenues from the HOT (hotel occupancy tax) exceeds projections and is a major source of funding. Donations, sponsorships, and naming rights will also be used for funding. The center will be comprised of four main facilities: a main arena, equestrian/livestock pavilion, exhibit hall, & warm up arena. Parking for RVs/trailers with full hook-ups is also included in the plans.

Construction of the facilities will be completed in phases, with the main arena included in Phase I. Food services in the facilities will be provided by United Supermarkets. Beer sales are also expected. The facilities will provide great locations for rodeo and livestock events, motor sports events, concerts, sporting events, trade/vendor exhibits and agricultural events.
