2 – Health & Wellness Ministry: Dental Clinic; Medical Clinic; Optometry Clinic w/Moody Inst. equipment; Pharmacy; & Soc. Services.

3 – Spiritual Ministry: Worship Service; Children/Youth Ministry; and 'Unpack' (Women only).

Some ministries are not 'in person' due to Covid, but are available by drive up, phone, and tele-medical.
