Guest Speaker Last Meeting!

Chase Head, Chief Development Officer, South Plains Food Bank, told us things we never knew! 1st- he's a fourth generation TTU grad! ...and he has extensive AG background & job experience! Joined the SPFB Board in 2014, and then became CDO of **SPFB!**

South Plains Food Bank's mission of ending hunger, giving hope and enriching lives through three main programs: **Children's Feeding, Mobile Pantry** and **Farm, Orchard, and GRUB** (F.O.G.)

Nearly 30,000 children are food-insecure on the South Plains. SPFB's **Children's Feeding Programs** reach these kids during the school year & summer. About 1,100 meals go to Boy/Girls Clubs.

The **SPFB** serves 20 different counties so the **Mobile Pantry** was created. Food boxes that are handed out at the food bank are loaded onto **SPFB** trucks and delivered to rural communities. Every family has food in their homes.

The **F.O.G.** programs help provide fresh produce for all the families we serve by planting, growing and harvesting thousands of pounds of vegetables, fruits, and herbs. **Growing Recruits for Urban Businesses**, or **GRUB**, allows the youth of the community to work on the farm while also providing educational and life-skill opportunities.

Skip Watson started the **'U Can Share'** donation program in 1983! 14 million lbs. of food were distributed in 2022, via 55,000 volunteer hours. Go online for **'Events'**!
