Bits & Pieces

Wayne, born & raised in Chicago, told me that the original **Ferris Wheel**, which debuted in 1893 (didn't realize Wayne was THAT old!) at the World's Columbian Exposition in Chicago, measured 250 feet tall and was a hit with riders. But it was less than half the size of the world's tallest Ferris wheel, **Ain Dubai**, which began spinning on the waterfront in Dubai in October 2021. Ain Dubai measures 820 feet tall, and riders can enjoy the air-conditioned 38-minute ride in a few different ways — by riding in one of the regular cabins, renting a private cabin, or buying a ticket for the **Skybar**: a pod that includes a full bar, a bartender, and music! Can only happen in Dubai! The wheel, whose name translates to 'the Dubai Eye' rises twice as high as the '**London Eye**'. Wayne said that Ferris wheel is in England!
