Lisa Gilliland, Executive Director of Lubbock Meals on Wheels, gave us a real 'state of **LMOW**'! Started in 1971 with 29 meal recipients, 50 years later over 800 elderly and home-bound recipients are receiving meals daily via 70 volunteers on 70 routes thru Lubbock and Wolfforth. Neither Govt. funds nor the United Way support **LMOW**. Nonetheless, philanthropic citizens, businesses, organizations of Lubbock Co., and fund raisers, provide over \$2 million for its yearly budget! A total of over 1,700 volunteers, 40 businesses, and Lion clubs, help man the routes, prepare and package meals, gather materials for distribution, and help the administrative staff.

Volunteers do so much more than deliver meals. For many homebound clients, a volunteer may be the only person they see each day. The hot, nutritious meal delivered is important but so is the daily human contact volunteers provide. Volunteers deliver many extra items such as calendars, birthday cakes on clients' birthdays, pet food, emergency meals, weekend meals, reading material, and fresh flowers most Fridays.

30th Annual Easy As Pie fundraiser was **Nov. 10th – Nov. 24th 2021**. **Lubbock Meals on Wheels, United Supermarkets, KAMC, KLBK, and Mrs. Smith's** teamed up to celebrate at all Lubbock **Amigos, Market Streets**, and **United Supermarkets**, and raised over \$75,000!
