Guest Speaker Last Week:

Adam Quap, Assistant Mgr., Hope Lodge, American Cancer Society, (ACS) gave us a good look of what the 3-story, beautiful (Tech architecture!) building located at 3511 10th St. does. It has 20,000 sq. ft. of living/eating areas, kitchen, & 32 bedrooms w/baths.

The **ACS Hope Lodge** program provides a free home away from home for cancer patients and their caregivers. It's a nurturing community that helps patients access the care they need. Each **Hope Lodge** community offers a supportive, homelike environment where guests can share a meal, join in activities, or unwind in their private room. Patients (12 & over) staying at a **Hope Lodge** must be in active cancer treatment and permanently reside more than 40 miles away from their cancer treatment center.

Established in 1970, the Charleston, SC **Hope Lodge** was the first facility of its kind in the country for cancer patients and caregivers. Margot Freudenberg, a leader in the Charleston medical and business communities, saw a similar facility while traveling through Australia and New Zealand with President Eisenhower's People to People Ambassador Program. After her own family was touched by cancer, Margot was determined to establish the first **Hope Lodge** community in Charleston. Now a nationwide program of the ACS, over 30 **Hope Lodge** facilities in the United States and Puerto Rico serve patients and caregivers from all over the world.

Actively involved in the **Hope Lodge** program until she was 105, Margot was the longest-serving ACS volunteer to date. Her attitude of gratitude, despite being forced from her home during the Nazi occupation of Germany, still inspires ACS today. Her legacy of grace, giving, and service live on through **Hope Lodge** volunteers.
