Guest Speaker Last Meeting:

Matt Rose serves as Public Affairs & Government Relations Mgr., Lubbock Power & Light. He also serves as the Spokesperson for the Utility. Since joining LP&L in 2013, Matt's responsibilities have included implementing new programs for educating customers on LP&L and City of Lubbock Utilities, working with local, state, and federal elected officials on matters of importance to the utility such the transition to ERCOT, retail electric competition, and implementing a messaging structure to educate the public on day-to-day operations. Matt worked in the Legislative Affairs Division of the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts focusing on the Texas electric industry over three legislative sessions.

In May 2013, LP&L began planning for energy needs for 2019 and beyond. Building an additional power plant would cost about \$700 Million. ERCOT already had power lines only one county away so it made financial sense to build transmission lines to connect with ERCOT instead of a new power plant. Joining ERCOT allows purchase of power from multiple sources bringing energy provider competition back to Lubbock. Lubbock is uniquely situated to have competition. The city owns power plants but these will be phased out as they become not cost effective. LP&L's main focus will be maintenance of power lines and substations. The cost of this is about \$42 million per year, but ERCOT will return \$45 million per year to the city for the maintenance. Powertochoose.org is the site that will allow customers to choose an energy provider. LP&L will be the delivery system. Rates will be roughly the same among providers. City of Lubbock will still provide call center information and will be the number for outages. Billing and other programs will begin a 12-month transition in Oct. 2022 to ensure that customers will not be hit with a large final bill when they change providers.
