Guest Speaker Last Meeting:

Abbey Reed, CEO, Family Guidance and Outreach Center (**FGOC**) of Lubbock, gave us details of what the Center has done since 1982. Abbey also brought **Chris Westbrook**, Parenting Instructor for the Shaken Baby Syndrome, to help answer questions. **Abbey** said **FGOC** is funded by grants, foundations, and fund raising. Contributions are always accepted.

On Dec. 13th, the Embers & Evergreen fundraiser will be at the Betenbough Center on 82nd St.; the Blue Flag Campaign in April 2023 when you can be a Friend of the Flag with a \$10 donation. In July, 2023, the Annual Clay Classic Charity 'Sporting Clays Shoot' occurs.

Abbey played a short video that stated 2,868 cases of child abuse were recorded in the panhandle region in 2021, including Lubbock Co. where 970 kids were abused (962 in 2020). 500+ kids were younger than 5; 248 were younger than 2; 117 were infants. 7 kids died in the region served, of which 4 kids died in Lubbock Co. last year.

Abbey said **FGOC** offers free parenting, wellness, life skills, & anger management classes for parents, grandparents, foster parents, daycare workers, & many more can attend, to get educated and feel empowered.

FGOC also provides free Outreach Programs for each elementary, middle and high school in Lubbock Co. and surrounding area schools. These programs deal with topics like anger, bullying, self-esteem & goal setting and much more.

Abbey said in 2021, more than 17,000 children were impacted by **FGOC**.

FGOC is committed to building & empowering families and daycare workers thru education & awareness, and envisions a region of communities with out child abuse & neglect.
