Kristin Murray, Executive Director, 'Voice of Hope' Texas, gave an insightful presentation. Formerly the Rape Crisis Center, and the 2nd oldest organization of its kind in Texas, V of H was founded in '75 & operates 24/7, 365 days a year!

Voice of Hope exists to: (a) provide victims of sexual violence in Lubbock and surrounding communities with free crisis assistance and advocacy without discrimination; and (b) promote public awareness of sexual violence through outreach, activism, and education.

Victim advocacy services provided:

- 24-hr Crisis Hotline
- 24-hr Medical Accompaniment
- 24-hr Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Service
- Counseling Services
- Law Enforcement Accompaniment
- Case Follow-Up & Referral
- Judicial Accompaniment
- Community Education Prog

In 2017, 462 rapes occurred in the Lubbock area, 58 against men. 85 were by family members/relatives!

Call **24-hour Crisis Hotline** at 806.763.7273 for more information. **V of H** provides assistance on behalf of child/adult survivors of sexual violence with third parties (*i.e. schools, employers, law enforcement agencies, health care professionals, prosecutor's offices, and Crime Victim's Compensation.*) Advocacy is provided by OAG certified trained staff and volunteers.
