Kerry a TTU grad and Civil Engineer from Monahans has 3 grown children. His middle son has special needs but was able to graduate H.S. and obtain a job at Longhorn Steak House for a brief time. He later joined HPV where he has built a community of HPV friends around him. Since most adult children with special needs can only live at home or in state or private group homes, it is important for them and their families to find places where they may experience and enjoy social and nurturing activities. HPV provides these opportunities for the villagers.

Kerry is trying to build support for residential cottages to be built at HPV, for residents 18 and older, to live, with supervision, on campus. That will give them a better chance of becoming self-sufficient, and an active member of society. By volunteering their services to other agencies, like the Food Bank or Meals on Wheels and finding ways to be engaged, villagers can find a purpose and enjoyment in their lives. HPV has several programs and projects on-going on campus.
