## Guest Speaker for Jan. 25th

**Jeanna Treider**, Lemur Rescuer, Ring Tail Ranch, with a 'live baby Red Kangaroo cradled by one of her volunteers, Alicia! Lil Red was wearing a diaper and literally swaddled in Alicia's arms the entire presentation. Several of us got pictures of Lil Red, and a rather 'still' video! See [ringtailranch.com](http://ringtailranch.com) **Jeanna** showed us her forearm where she had 60+ stitches to close the slashing wound she got from an adult lemur. Jeanna said they don't just 'bite', they bite/slash which is why they are not PETS! **Jeanna** said there are 100+ known species of lemurs in 5 genus 'families'. All are wild animals but the Ring-tailed lemur, because it is so cute when a baby, is poached and sold to animal traders and then pet shops around the world as a "poor man's monkey". Lemurs from Madagascar, an island country, is rapidly losing their forest habitat. **Jeanna** has 40 lemurs, 34 of them 'rescued' from former owners who were no longer able to keep them. About 40 species of lemurs live on **Jeanna** spends about \$130 a day to feed the lemurs, 2 Red Kangaroos, 2 Kinkajous, 1 mini horse & a Cockatoo, too! World Lemur Day is coming Sept. 19<sup>th</sup> and she hopes her Ring-Tail Ranch is finished by then (4 large outside enclosures). It's currently open to the public but by appointment only for groups, 25-30, or families. NEWS FLASH! 12 more lemurs were given to the ranch, but another enclosure is needed!
