## Guest Speaker Last Week:

**Emily Wilkinson**, Facilities Planning & Construction, and TX Public Arts Program coordinator, gave us all a very 'illustrative' presentation of some of the 131 pieces of art on our Tech campus and on the other campuses within the TTU system.

**Emily** was formerly with the Ranching Heritage Museum.

**Emily** said that since 2001, the TTU System's Public Art Collection has been named one of the top 10 university public art collections in the U.S. by Public Art Review, the leading journal in the field of public art. Since 2001, 1% of every new building's budget must go toward a new 'piece(s) art outside/within the structure. The bronze statue of Will Rodgers on campus is the oldest art piece.

**Emily** said artists throughout the U.S., and the world, can apply. The application includes photos of their art piece and a written synopsis of what it represents, along with photos of 15 of their past art pieces. A scaled model may also be required

After reviewing submissions of over 100 artists for the last art piece, the review committee gave their recommendation to the President and Chancellor for final approval. **Emily** presented slides of many of the beautiful or unique art found on our campus and on campuses in the TTU System. She also made available copies of a small illustrated book entitled **Public Art Collection: TTU System**.
