## Guest Speaker Last Meeting

**Jennifer Wang**, International Admissions Counselor, Undergrad Admissions, and **Kaitlyn English**, Intrntl. Recruitment Counselor, TTU, gave us insight on Tech's global reach for students. They had a video on Intrntl. Student Life but as usual, we couldn't view it!

**Jennifer & Kaitlyn** work thru the Office of Intrntl. Affairs and the Global Guide Program, that pays students for their community interactions. A total of 1,800+ students from 100+ countries are currently attending Tech, mostly in graduate degree programs. India and Bangladesh are where most students are from. Many students must stay in rental properties in Lubbock and are taken to Wal-Mart 1<sup>st</sup> to buy essentials. Then transportation to campus and elsewhere is worked out. Undergrad students live mostly in the 19 dorms on campus.

**Kaitlyn** said all Intrntl. students must be conversationally proficient in English, and *Presidential Merit & Proven Achievers* Scholarships, along with External ones via various Tech departments, are available. Tech is relatively affordable for students at \$29,145, the same tuition as in-state students pay.

The **International Center for Arid and Semiarid Land Studies (ICASALS)** at TTU was created in 1966 to promote interdisciplinary study of arid/semiarid environments/technology for foreign students.
