Dr. Charity Embley, Director of **The Inside Out Foundation** of Lubbock. Charity is on the faculty at TTUHSC, an Associate faculty member of UTPB in Odessa, and she is an editor for Copy Press, Tampa, FL. She teaches scientific and resume writing for the interns and residents, and research writing for staff doctors. Charity became a new member of our club, and she and her husband George are new Lubbock residents.

The **Inside Out Foundation** is a charity, since 2016, that survives only on donations. Its' primary role is to assist women who are cancer victims to get back their self-esteem. Providing wigs, skin care (make-up) and prosthetics (breast mastectomies), and assisting burn victims to be less self-conscious of their scarring. **Inside Out** tries to enhance appearances and self-image, and assists men, also. **Inside Out** provided about 650 services last year. **Inside Out** also assists patrons with traumas, if needed, whether they come by themselves, or with spouse, parent, or a friend.

Inside Out has a Boutique that sells specialty items for patrons & provides additional funding. **Inside Out** also sponsors **Events:**
