Guest Speakers for Feb. 29th

Bret Lamkin, Treasurer, and **Mark Bachman, Secretary,** Lubbock County Expo Center, gave us an expansive update on the progress of the **Center**. First off, 45 acres of the 135-acre site was extraneous, so 30 acres are up for sale to help pay for the **Center**. 90 acres remains for facilities and parking. Our own **Kim Davis** has been their promotional advocate from the beginning! Biggest hurdle to 'success' has been the increase in scope/cost of the **Center**, which keeps moving the 'goal post'!! We saw a '**Virtual Tour**' video that takes you thru a mock-up of the **Coliseum** and the three supporting buildings: Warm-up, Stock pens, & Stock showings. All buildings can be reconfigured for other events.

In 2018 Lubbock voters approved a tax on vehicle rentals and hotel/motel room rentals that has raised about \$40 mil. so far. \$30 mil. has been pledged, so \$17 mil. remains.

In 2020 the 'variance' on the site was approved for the **Center**.

In 2023 the '**Virtual Tour**' video was produced. It needs 'narration' to explain what is being shown.

The 'Name' of the **Coliseum** has been sold (20 yrs.), along with the smaller buildings. **Kubota & Coors** are committed sponsors, and other companies are potential sponsors.

Site preparation is ongoing (Univ. & N. Loop) & groundbreaking on the **Center** will be later this year.
