John Sigle, Agency President, **Texas Girls & Boys Ranch**, gave us an update on Ranch activities. **John** is an Air Force Vet of 22 yrs, 6 as a Drill Sgt! He graduated from Tech, and has 2 MA's, 2nd in Child Development. He & his wife have served as Foster & Adoptive parents. They have 3 adult children and 5 grandkids, all boys!

John was asked to 'assess' the Ranch's 'organization' in 1995, when it served only 'delinquent' boys, and ended up joining the staff, in 2002, when it served **all boys**.

In 2010, the Ranch started taking girls, also.

In 2014, the Ranch added Foster and Adoptive Services. Also that year, they opened an Emergency Shelter after the So. Plains Shelter was closed.

In 2021, Ranch adopted their 'new' name: **TX Girls & Boys Ranch!**

In 2023, the 'Turning Point' Program for delinquent foster kids was initiated in Lubbock. **Focus areas:**
