Their goal is to send as many veterans, WWII, Korea, Viet Nam, to Washington D.C. to pay homage to their fellow brothers and sister in arms by visiting the War and Service Memorials built in their honor.

MISSION- To ensure that every Veteran has a chance to pay their respects to their brothers and sisters that fought for our country and interned in our National Cemeteries.

WHAT THEY DO- Once a year they send approximately 120 WWII, Korean, and Vietnam Veterans on an all-expensepaid trip to Washington D.C.

COMMUNITY-Their organization is comprised entirely of volunteers who take time out of their lives to ensure this trip of a lifetime is possible for these so deserving veterans.
