Guest Speaker Last Meeting

Poppy Beard, President, Unpack Ministries, Lubbock. Poppy went back to school in her 40's and earned an M.A. in Human Science with an emphasis in Family Life Education at TTU. Poppy turned **Unpack** into a ministry in 2012 and in 2016 gained **Unpack** as a non-profit as a 501(c3). Currently, **Unpack** has been in the Lubbock Impact building, 2nd floor, since 2014.

Unpack is a two-tiered approach to help women unpack the pain of their pasts as well as help them on the road to residency where they can make a home for themselves and their children. **Unpack** works with single women; some out of incarceration, some out of abusive relationships, and others facing unforeseen circumstances where they are starting anew. If these women get an understanding of who they were created to be, they can succeed in all areas of life.

Unpack has ministered to numerous women in our community by providing support, encouragement and resources, and have seen significant progress in their lives. They are pushed hard to succeed, to grow, so they can teach their children to respect authority, look after themselves, and solve problems they themselves may be creating. About \$3,200 a yr. is spent per woman to assist them. **Poppy** discovered that 51% of households in Lubbock are run by single parents or grandparents. Currently, 38-42 women are attending Wed. meetings. To volunteer or donate items needed, call 239-6160.
