Guest Speaker Last Meeting!

Sandy Fortenberry, Chair, Lubbock County Historical Commission, gave us a very comprehensive presentation on Lubbock's National Register of Historic Places. **Sandy** was appointed by the Co. Commissioners for a 2 yr. term as chair of the 18-member Historical Commission. Surveys of buildings in Lubbock city & county are conducted and Lubbock is one of 10 counties that has Certified Local Government Review of all construction in order to preserve Historical Valuable Areas & Buildings.

Sandy said since 1966 the TTU campus is a Historic District Site. Dr. Joseph A. Chatman came to Lubbock in 1939 and opened his hospital in 1945, the only hospital in segregated Lubbock serving the African American residents of east Lubbock. It is now the Chatman Community Health Center. This was just a couple of several sites and buildings in Lubbock that **Sandy** told us about.

Sandy said there are over 16,000 Historical Markers in Texas, and since the 1960's, there are 57 markers in Lubbock County.

Sandy then gave us a summary of historical happenings in Lubbock city and county, too many for me to mention here. You need to come to the meetings to be properly educated and informed! **Sandy** handed out duplexed red sheets that listed the Lubbock Co. Historic Markers and all the Lubbock National Register of Historic Places with the dates they were listed. At: Lubbock Co. Historical Commission
