Kelly said he wanted to see Prop. A defeated, as it was, substantially. He went on to say that the Border Issue hasn't affected Lubbock much directly, but it has taken too many Border Patrol agents off their normal task of searching vehicles for drugs and other contraband. Interior Border Stations have been undermanned. Fentanyl is the biggest threat to our young people and anyone taking pills that don't come from a pharmacy. 33 Kilos of Crystal Meth was confiscated, and millions of pills laced with fentanyl. Kelly said about 90% of theft and mugging crimes, for the last 40 vears, have been committed by drug addicts trying to support their addictions. Kelly surprised us when he said that about 85 different gangs with over 2,000 documented gang members in Texas.

Kelly said the High-Intensity Drug Trafficking Agency in Lubbock is doing fine, and the Sheriff's Dept. has a 98% clearance on homicides. May 23, 2024
