### **Guest Speaker Last Week:**

Jeff Gibson. President of the Challenger Division of Little League (CDLL), a program for developmentally and physically challenged youth, helping them enjoy the benefits of Little League (LL) participation in an athletic environment structured to their abilities. More than skills of baseball are learned. The value of the CDLL are the proven therapeutic and socialization benefits of participating in sports; the strengthening of participants' self-esteem; the opportunities to mainstream into other types of play and the discipline of teamwork, sportsmanship and fair play, which are hallmarks of the LL program. The CDLL provides the framework so LL programs offer a structured athletic activity for all youth. Playing with the same equipment, CDLL participants experience the joys of pulling together as a team, being cheered, and earning awards for their achievements.

**CDLL** teams are set up according to abilities, not age, and can include as many as 15-20 players. **Challenger** games can be played as 'tee' ball, coach pitch, player pitch, or a combination of all three, & as "beeper" ball!

In a **Challenger** game, each player gets a chance to bat. The side is retired when the offense has batted through the roster. **LL** recommends that no score be kept during **Challenger** games. The **Challenger** players wear the same uniforms, shoulder patches and safety equipment as other **LL** players.

One of the benefits of **CDLL** is that it encourages the use of "buddies" for the **Challenger** players. The buddies assist the **Challenger** players on the field, and when possible, encourage the players to bat and make plays themselves. However, the buddy is always nearby to help.

**CDLL** was founded in 1989 with over 22,000 players nationally. Fees are requested to defray costs, but waivers are offered & no children are denied the opportunity to play. Call League Coordinator (806) 777-5141.
