Guest Speaker Last Meeting!

Lea Ann Lust, Program Mgr., **National Ranching Heritage Center**, 3121 4th St., presented a very informative slide presentation. **Lea** started at the **NRHC** April 2020, after being an Aide to Chancellor Robert Duncan. **Lea Ann** said the **NRHC** actually goes back to 1966 when **William C. Holden** obtained the use of 26 acres of the campus for a facility similar to a Heritage Center he saw in Norway. **Mr. Holden** wanted to do a heritage center similar to Williamsburg, VA, but focusing on ranching. Finally started in '74, in the late '70s the facility was opened to the public, free admission, once a year. Currently, the **NRHC** has 55 structures, 54 of them in their original form. Oldest structure is the Los Corilitas, dating back to the late 1700's. Students from all around Lubbock and eastern New Mexico come to the **NRHC**; over 7,000 come each year. The last three acquisitions were the Matador Ranch 'line camp house' last year, a 22' tall Eclipse windmill in 2021, and an Episcopal church in 2020. The main building incorporates several different galleries: 1. Spur Collection; 2. Clothing 1880's era; 3. Western paintings; 4. Oil & Gas; 5. Cattle; and 6. Collections – encompassing branding irons, barbed wire, fire arms, and store/shop/inn containers and items sold and used during the 1880-1930's. Video presentations also available!

Ranch Week is July 10th-14th for 1st – 5th graders; **Ranch Day**, April 22, 2023, is for the general public.
