Guest Speaker for Nov. 2nd!

Candace Berlinga, Owner / Feng Shui Consultant, Feng Shui by Candace, brought us a very interesting program! Candace said she has a radio program the first Tues. of each month, starting at 9:00 am on 580 AM, and 95.9 FM, that you can tune in to Feng Shui! Candace gave a video presentation on Feng Shui, telling us what it is: the feeling you get of calmness & serenity from an indoor room, home setting, outdoor garden/patio space, or a 'nature setting' or manmade outdoor space. It is NOT religion or associated with any cult or religion.

Feng shui, also known as Chinese geomancy, is an ancient Chinese traditional practice which claims to use energy forces to harmonize individuals with their surrounding environment. The term feng shui means, literally, "wind-water."

From ancient times, landscapes and bodies of water were thought to direct the flow of the universal Qi – "cosmic current" or energy. It is an ancient Chinese thought process, or a system of laws considered to govern spatial arrangement and orientation in relation to the flow of energy (qi), and whose favorable or unfavorable effects are taken into account when siting and designing buildings or manmade outdoor spaces/landscapes. By definition, feng shui is the practice of arranging pieces (furniture/art/decorations/wall hangings) in living spaces to create balance with the natural world. This is what it means to feng shui your home. The goal is to harness energy forces and establish harmony between an individual and their environment.

Candace presented a few books: Feng Shui, for home buyers: Interior Design, and Feng Shui for home buyers for Exterior Design, and Designing for Autism Spectrum Disorder, and Creating Places of Power.
