### **Guest Speaker Last Meeting**

Jarrett Atkinson, Lubbock City Manager, presented an interesting perspective of our city: its history, current status, and future growth. Population in 1970 was 149,000; 2010: 229,573; 2020: 257,741; today: 261,000! A steady 2% growth rate. 11<sup>th</sup> most populous city in TX and the 86<sup>th</sup> most in the U.S. Co. has 330,000 population. City is now 143 sq. miles in area!

Construction Permits f/houses & duplexes: '19: 1,329; '20: 1,826; '21: 2,428; '22 so far: 1,726; down due to economic/interest changes. Commercial: '19: 381; '20: 362; '21: 303; '22: 324 so far.

City income via Sales Tax: '18: 67.44 Mil. \$; '19: 71.65; '20: 73.98; '21: 82.72; '22: 91.69.
