Guest Speaker Last Meeting

Sabrina Marcum, MS, Children's Mental Health System Navigator, StarCare Lubbock, gave us an informative message. First off, StarCare is the former MHMR. Sabrina's emphasis today was Youth (3-17) Mental Health & Addiction issues such as alcohol, drugs, opiates, & vaping, which are greater problems in our region than most areas of TX. And, most obvious, but most perplexing to parents and teachers, is phone media addiction! **Sabrina** emphasized that parents/grandparents must restrict the use of phones by their children (don't take them to bed, dinner table, or any other inappropriate place). AND, that kids' phones must be screened for inappropriate use, searches, websites, and correspondence. Kids NEED parental supervision, and that is not an invasion of their privacy! Too many children are being 'addicted' to certain websites and social media 'celebrities', and are being harmed by them.

Sabrina told us about HEARD, Helping Every Adolescent Reach their Dreams. H.E.A.R.D. is a group of community members from every sector of Lubbock. The mission of H.E.A.R.D. is to strengthen community infrastructure, provide connections and resources, advocate with youth, and enact change in order to prevent substance use and reduce its impact on youth and young adults in the Lubbock area. 'Rainbow' fentanyl tablets are the new attraction for kids! Colored like candy! It's very easy to get drugs in Lubbock and our 15-county region. StarCare's Sunrise Canyon Hospital in Lubbock provides short-term psychiatric treatment in a 30-bed inpatient facility to both men and women 18 or older. Treatment is designed to reduce symptoms of mental illness and is provided in a secure environment where care is provided by clinical staff and supervised by licensed psychiatrists For Children's Mental Health Services, call 806-620-7556.
