Guest Speaker Last Meeting

Sherry Sancibrian, MS, Assoc. Chair, Dept. of Speech, Language, & Hearing Sciences, TTUHSC, gave a very informative presentation on what her Dept. provides.

Sherry said the **Cochlear Implant Clinic** has adopted a brain stem implant (from Italy), that will enhance hearing for the deaf. The **Audiology Clinic**, with Speech Therapists, are helping the hearing impaired, and the **STAR** program, (STroke, Aphasia, Recovery) has a clinic that assists stroke patients that have loss of language. The **Feeding Clinic** assists patients who have loss of swallowing. This clinic also treats behavioral/picky eaters, & infants w/reflux problems.

Sherry also commented on the **Children's Therapy Programs** that cover Autism and behavior issues, and the **Summer Tech Tykes** program that partners with the Science Spectrum and the All Saints School. The **Summer Chatty Champions** program makes kids speech more understandable, and the **Wee Read Club** helps get kids reading 'books' instead of staring into phones! **Language & Literacy** is teaching kids to read by being taught sounds (Phonetics!), and **Individual Therapy** for one-on-one efforts, and **Aural Rehab**, takes kids that couldn't talk and with a neurological device, that uses pictures/ letters raises reading to 1st grade!
