Guest Speaker Last Meeting!

Meghan O'Rourke, Communications Coordinator, Ronald McDonald House, Update on House. (Sandra's notes!)

Meghan said the Ronald McDonald House (**RMH**) opened March 10, 1988, celebrating its 35th anniversary! Their mission is to provide families with a sick child a comfortable home-away-from-home when the child is in the hospital. There are 17 guest rooms. While staying at the house, families can access meals, laundry & a playroom. Families are referred to **RMH** by a hospital social worker.

In 2004, the **RMH** of Lubbock & House of the Permian Basin joined to form **RMH** Charities of the Southwest serving 68 counties in TX & eastern NM. In 2006, three **RMH** Family Room programs were opened at Medical Center Hospital Odessa, UMC, and Covenant Children's Hospital. These rooms offer respite for families inside the hospital. Families do laundry, take showers, have snacks or coffee. In 2022, a family room was added at Midland Memorial Hospital.

Early 2023, the 'Cart with a Heart' program rolled out. The cart brings comfort items to patients' doors in the hospital.

During 35 years of service, **RMH** served 10,000 families with 217,000 nights of sleep, 383,000 meals & 25,000 visits to **RMH** Family Rooms in the four hospitals.

Meghan told us that there are many opportunities to volunteer at **RMH**! Be a guest chef, clean the house, put together welcome bags, provide 'house to home' items, gas or gift cards. **Call Meghan: 744-8877, to volunteer!**

85% of donations go to program costs. Cost per night is \$100; the average stay is 11 nights. You can support the work of **RMH** by following on Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, & TikTok.
