Guest Speaker Last Meeting!

Dr. Brian Payne/Misti Welch, Chief Med. Off. UMC Childrens' Hosp./Dir. Childrens' Mir. Network, gave us all a video presentation of the **CMN**, which has been going for 40 years! Dr. Brian Payne has been CMO since 2016, and came to UMC from St. Louis, where he was the 1st to practice Pediatric Emergency Care. The video told us:

Over 10 million kids enter a children's hospital across N. America every year. To provide the best care for kids, children's hospitals rely on donations and community support, as Medicaid and insurance programs do not fully cover the cost of care. Since 1983, **CMN** Hospitals have helped fill those funding gaps by raising more than \$7 billion, most of it \$1 at a time through **Miracle Balloon** icon campaigns. Its fundraising partners and programs support the nonprofit's mission to save/improve the lives of as many kids as possible. Member children's hospitals are available 24/7 to help kids of every age and background overcome every injury and illness imaginable. These children's hospitals are also on the front lines of preventing disease and injury via research, education and outreach/vaccine programs that keep millions of kids out of the hospital each year. This year, **CMN** Hospitals' members will provide \$3.4 billion in charity care alone. **CMN** keeps funds within the community in which they are raised. Donations are given to local hospitals who know where the need is greatest and decide how that money is best spent. Donations go to support research/training, purchase equipment & pay for uncompensated care. **UMC CMN** has 1st: Pediatric ICU; 1st Neonatal ICU; 1st Hospital designated Level I Trauma & Pediatric Level II Trauma Centers; 1st Regional Burn Center treating kids; 1st Children's Oncology Group program with dedicated pediatric clinical trials; 1st Life-support Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation (ECMO) machines in USA! **WOW!**

Member Biography

Charles Zeeck, 85 yrs. old and long retired, was born in the Panama Canal Zone, Dad was an electrician there near the end of the depression! Married to Vieta for 65 yrs., they have three sons: two TTU grads and 1 Air Force Academy, who spent 21 yrs. in the AF & was an F-4 Phantom pilot. That plane could handle air-to air & air to-ground combat, strikes against air defense & recon sorties! Has 5 grand kids & 8 great grandkids! **Charles** started in H.S. Key Club, became President, then became a Kiwanis Club member. He rose thru the ranks to be Lt. Governor twice! Said his friend Art Swanberg was a Lt. Gov also, then elected a Trustee of Kiwanis International. He and Art would hand out Dallas Cowboy cards to kids if they came up to them! **Charles** helped chair Kiwanis's campaign with UNICEF from '94-'05, against iodine deficiency, that resulted in iodized salt. During that time, the **Kiwanis Children's Fund** raised over \$105 million for salt iodization, testing/monitoring, and community outreach & education, in more than 89 nations. 88% of the world's households have access to iodized salt; that kept hundreds of millions of children from preventable intellectual & developmental disabilities. **Editor's note:** In 2010, Kiwanis Intl. launched **The Eliminate Project**, a global campaign, w/UNICEF, to eliminate maternal/neonatal tetanus (MNT) with vaccines & promotion of clean delivery & umbilical cord care practices. Newborn deaths have dropped 57% per WHO. 47 nations done, 12 to go!
