Guest Speaker Last Meeting:

Tom Vermillion, Executive Director, Lubbock Boys & Girls Clubs, gave us an update on how the clubs have expanded in number and services. A Boy's Club was started in Lubbock in 1940, and there are now 4 clubs (and a 5th in Shallowater). Clubs are finally now open to children. Before Covid, 1,200 kids were members, now 1,500 kids, age 6-17, are members! A 'teen center' has been started, the older teens haven't come, we get a lot of 'pre-teens' from Jr. Highs participating. Food at clubs is provided by the **So. Plains Food Bank**, and vans have been acquired to take kids on 'field trips' to museums and points of interest.

Talkington Club is the newest, and is in the Frenship school district where there is a need to serve kids. '**Summer Torch**' games are beginning, where those that 'compete' get awards. **United Supermarkets** gave a grant to help the clubs assist kids with homework, reading and math especially!

Christmas in July is coming! Kids design and make Christmas Cards, and the winners get a \$25 gift card. The best designs are printed and sold as a fund raiser! **Career Day**, sponsored by Coca-Cola and Old Navy this year, provides older kids an opportunity to acquire skills in vocations via the Apprentice Program at a Talkington center. The **Drone Program**, with 2 drones, beat out 17 other teams from ISD's! The **Robotics Program** is starting again in the Shallowater Club. And, a new **Athletic Director** on staff, is putting together a **Sports Program** for kids not able to make it on teams in their schools.

July 21st is the 29th **Annual Jr. Golf Tournament**, \$25 entry fee per kid.
