## Guest Speaker Last Meeting!

**Kyle Bonath**, Chief of Police, TTU Police Dept., gave us a 'State of the Campus' view from the 'Safety and Enforcement' perspective. **Kyle** became Chief in 2015 after he retired from the FBI after 25 years, where he handled 'white collar' crime. **Kyle** graduated from TTU with a B.A./M.B.A. in Accounting. Kyle oversees 58 officers on the Tech/HSC campuses (24/7 coverage), and 55 officers on 4 other Tech campuses, and 23 staff employees too!

He mentioned that the biggest crime on campus is bike theft, usually by drug addicts that use large chain cutters, 'fencing' bikes to support their addiction.

The Tech campus is also a 'rich environment' for car theft. A 'car-jacking' (with a knife) actually occurred (that was a Federal Offense!). The Fall semesters usually have the highest rate of 'activities' due to in-coming freshmen who are away from 'home authority' for the 1<sup>st</sup> time. Sexual Assault always occurs, unfortunately, but **Kyle** said they have a 100% 'crime solution' so far!

Drugs also are always a problem and recently 1,000 Fentanyl pills were confiscated on the El Paso campus. During Tech football games, LPD and LSO canine units & 4 'snipers' are used at each game! THAT was a 'revelation'!
