Guest Speaker Last Week:

Mark Brown, Director of Field Services, Plains Cotton Growers, gave us a full accounting of just how big the association is, covering 42 counties from S. of Odessa thru to the panhandle N. of Amarillo. Organized in 1956 by cotton producers from across the High Plains production region, **PCG** is a non-profit producer organization composed of cotton producers from the TX High Plains. 4.7 million bales!

Legislation: PCG helps develop legislative programs and rules for implementation at the state and national level. We also work with the National Cotton Council on many issues including the Farm Bill, trade issues, State and Federal Agriculture Appropriations, Crop Insurance Reform and Improvement, and Conservation.

Research: Relationships between **PCG**, Texas A&M Agri-life Extension, Texas A&M Agri-life Research, Cotton Incorporated, universities, and numerous others have helped advance High Plains cotton into a valued player in the world market. **PCG's** producer-funded Plains Cotton Improvement Program supports various research efforts (TTU) designed to improve our product for years to come.

Surprisingly, **Mark** said about 65% of cotton is dry land, only 35% is irrigated! Last year was one of the best harvests due to timely rains, not the amount. Dry land yields are 250-650 lbs. per acre, irrigated can be 500-1,500 per acre! The Ogallala aquifer is diminishing & farms, as well as county subdivisions, are becoming dry. Just 4 million bales sold for \$1.3 billion last year! Cotton is currently at \$.65 a pound.
