## Guest Speaker for Nov. 16th!

**Joshua Fowler**, a blood recipient and an advocate for Vitalant, was invited by **James Dugger** to give a very personal account of his recovery after a severe injury. **Josh** and his wife have 4 kids and they live in Lubbock.

**Josh** told us he was involved in a bad accident when his vehicle, going 75 mph, hit a semi-trailer truck on May 19<sup>th</sup>, 2020, outside of Brownfield. His air bags **didn't** deploy!...and it took 45 minutes to extract him from his vehicle using Jaws of Life! The accident occurred two months into Covid and our blood supply was at a minimum due to lack of donors. The Medi-Vac helicopter had no blood on it as it took him to the hospital. **Josh** suffered vertebrae damage to C2 & C4, 13 broken ribs, split sternum, broken knee caps, ankles, leg bones. He got to UMC within 58 minutes of the accident, and luckily had no paralysis! But there was still a shortage of blood! Six months later **Josh** was walking with a cane, and started looking for a job. The hardware was removed from his left leg, but the bone was infected and amputation might be necessary. A surgeon was found who could operate to save the bone (no amputation!). **Josh** has had more than surgeries, requiring 13 units of blood. His relatives were asked to provide blood due to shortages. **Josh** had knee surgery October and needs one more plus blood. **Josh** needed round the clock care during time out of the hospital; his retired dad took him in to care for him. His dad became his 'best friend'! Unfortunately, he passed May 17, 2022. "My wife was the real champion", **Josh** said, taking care of 4 youngsters while he was trying to heal. **James** told us it's NOT hard to donate blood/plasma to allow surgeries & to save a life! Platelets are needed but that takes longer. But **please** donate!
