Guest Speaker Last Meeting!

Matt Rose, Public Affairs & Governmental Relations Mgr., LP&L, gave us all an insight of the coming changes to our electrical service!

Matt began by handing out a 14-page Retail Electric Competition Customer Shopping Guide to each attending member. **Matt** told us that shopping for an electric service provider has been pushed back from Oct. 1st to the 1st of 2024 and that the Shopping Guide should provide answers to nearly all the questions electric customers should have. For 20 years, most Texans have been picking electric service from dozens of providers in their electric grid area.

We will have about 6 weeks to shop, and if we don't select a provider, one of three power companies will be selected for us! Out of the 96 entities that went thru testing by the State, 20-30 will be offering us their rates and services. Other entities will be focusing on local businesses & organizations. **Matt** said that Walmart has their own contract electricity provider, as do other major corporations.

Matt said everyone must obtain the past 12 months of electric consumption for their home, rental property and business, and list the amount of electricity that was used per month. **NOT** the cost, but the **kilowatt hours** used each month. Providers will quote rates by KW!
