Since 2004, **Visit Lubbock** has booked more than 3,579 events or conventions, resulting in 2.86 million visitors, 943,570 room nights, and \$297 million in direct economic impact to the Lubbock area. However, **Lubbock Sports**, just in the last 5 years, has brought 1,200 events, and 800,000 room nights, and 80% of the events are annual! **Visit Lubbock** is an accredited destination marketing organization designated by DMAI (Destination Marketing Association International).

Lubbock Sports promotes the use of athletic facilities in Lubbock such as Burl Huffman Center f/Archery, Pete Ragus Swim Center, Burgess-Rushing Tennis Center, Lubbock Youth Sports Complex for baseball and softball, Lowery Field, as well as the Apex Event Center, Rock Solid Athletics, and South Plains Lanes. On the Tech campus, Sports Performance Center, John Walker Soccer Complex, TTU Equestrian Center, Dan Law Baseball Field and Rocky Johnson Softball Field are utilized for events.
