Guest Speaker Last Week:

Dr. Robin Satterwhite, President of South Plains College (SPC) gave us a great update on how SPC has been growing and serving students of West Texas and beyond! Dr. Satterwhite earned all three of his degrees at SPC and TTU! A native of Ropesville, and President since 2016, he and his wife Delores have 3 daughters, SPC & TTU grads!

SPC has over 9,000 students, mostly from 13 counties around Lubbock. Only Hockley Co. and part of Cochran Co. are taxed to support SPC. 'Dual-Credit' high school students now are the majority of SPC students. 72 ISD's now offer this program to their 11th and 12th graders. The majority of SPC students go on to TTU f/4yr degrees.

SPC has 4 campuses! Main campus in Levelland with a new 30,000 sq. ft. addition to the Science Bldg. (45% of students), Reese Technology Center, Plainview campus and 39th & Ave. Q campus. Opening this fall is the 84,000 sq. ft. former Lubbock City Hall (Sears bldg.) that will have 50 classrooms for Arts & Sciences. The Ave. Q campus will be kept. 60% of all SPC students come from Lubbock Co. 100's of **SPC** students are co-enrolled at Tech, LCU or Wayland.

SPC offers 106 Vocational Certificates / Apprenticeships. Welding, Physical Therapists, Wind Turbine Technicians, Electricians, are just some of the most popular curriculums offered. Over 1.100 courses are offered. 75-80% of all SPC students earn an Associate or Advanced degree or Vocational Certificate, which is a high grad rate!

SPC tuition is 48% of TTU's tuition, and just 29% of private universities. SPC graduates get a \$4,000 scholarship at TTU! Class size at SPC is 25-30, and no 'mass' classes! All classes are taught by PhD. Professors or M.S./ M.A. degreed instructors. No Gr. Asst.
