Guest Speaker Last Meeting!

John Osborne, President & CEO, Lubbock Economic Development Alliance, had experience in three previous positions before coming to Lubbock, and received 2 national awards in economic development! Glad he's here in Lubbock!

John said that **LEDA** entered a Public/Private Partnership with Plant Agricultural Systems (PLANT-AS) creating over 900 jobs and investing \$670 million and 13.3 mil. square feet of advanced controlled environment ag production facilities on 700 acres located off East Loop 289 and Erskine St. where fresh produce, including, but not limited to, leafy greens and vine crops like tomatoes & strawberries, will be produced using hydroponic technology.

John announced that **Leprino** Cheese company is building it's 850,000 sq. ft. plant in E. Lubbock, a \$870 million capital investment expected to employ approximately 600 full-time personnel when it is fully operational. The facility will produce mozzarella and dairy ingredients. Soon 200 tankers of milk a day will be processed and 'dirty water' by-product will be treated to 'stream quality' and discharged to lake #6 that will eventually flow into lake #7 and become a source of drinking water for us!

John said that our current water supply will allow Lubbock to add 130,000 to our current population of 261,000. CoNextrix, TrueNorth Steel, and Taylor Rig & Equipment are expanding and adding 145+ jobs to our economy!
