Guest Speaker on Oct. 21th:

Sharon McCullar, Curator since Oct. 2016, Lubbock's "Silent Wings Museum", Preston Smith Int'l. Airport. **Sharon** gave us a very historical, and personable, presentation about the gliders, their pilots and crews who trained for 6-8 weeks during '42-'43. South Plains Army Air Field is where they were stationed. About 6,000 of the 7,200 pilots trained were trained there. 13,909 gliders were built by Ford Motor Co. in Michigan with the help of 18 other companies. Nearly 7,000 gliders were shipped overseas to areas secured for take-offs into areas behind German lines. Gliders costing \$25,000 were towed by C-47 air planes costing \$70,000. Each glider had 12 Army infantry soldiers plus the pilot. The gliders were towed 350' behind the plane and some had a vehicle or a small artillery piece in them along with infantry and artillery personnel. For additional information on gliders used during WWII read, *Pegasus Bridge* by Stephen Ambrose.

Sharon said the museum is in the former Lubbock Air Terminal building. The museum originally started in the Terrell, TX, airport in 1984, but was relocated to Lubbock in 2002. The museum offers in-person and virtual educational programs, group tours, and field trips year-round! The Silent Wings Museum, a public institution, preserves and promotes the history of the World War II military glider program by creating an environment for collecting, documenting, interpreting and exhibiting artifacts and information for public education and enjoyment. **Admission costs:** \$10, \$8 seniors, \$5 for kids 7-17.
