Guest Speaker Last Meeting

David Cho, Music Director & Conductor, Lubbock Symphony Orchestra, was our Guest Speaker AND Guest Performer! David's parents immigrated to the US from Seoul, Korea when he was just a kid, and 'boy! are we glad!' **David** has won numerous awards in his earlier career, and has been our LSO director/conductor since 2011. **David** was just given a 4-yr. contract to extend his stay in Lubbock, a city he said he really calls 'home'!

David said the performance of "Brno" by the Czech Republic Orchestra, was a success. Their director said Lubbock was the only city they performed in that gave them a post-performance party, and David was a great host.

The LSO is wrapping up their 76th season with Carmen suites in "Carmen in Gold" featuring pianist Kenny Broberg. **David** also mentioned that **Joe Phea**, performed '67-'69 with his former teacher, the well-known jazz musician and Dunbar band conductor, J. T. Braxton, in the Roy Roberts jazz band after graduation. **Joe** is still performing...go ask him where!

David said the Lubbock Youth Orchestra is once again under LSO's umbrella, and mentioned that John Williams music, 'Star Wars', will be performed May 4th 2024, along with 'Best Of' oratorios: Handel's 'Messiah'; Mendelson's 'The Creation'; and Johannes Brahms pieces, which will be brought to us by Braum's restaurants!

Next season's tickets go on sale in June, and the LSO Board decided to eliminate the top balcony seats and bring those seat holders down to the next level to 'consolidate' the audience (and provide more comfy seating)!

David then performed, on his key board, Ludwig van Beethoven's *Fur Elise*, and other songs. Had to stop for lack of time, but not ours!
