Guest Speakers Last Week:

Our “mystery guest speaker” was our own **Jimmy Moore**, or did Holly Patton morph into **Luke Mason**, who’s the Gifts & Special Events Coord. for the **Children’s Home**? **Luke** is married and was a House Dad since 2017. Originally from Vega, TX, he has since made Lubbock his home. He and **Jimmy** explained how **Children’s Home** has evolved over the last few years and especially since changes in the laws for orphan and foster kids and COVID. Children’s Home of Lubbock is still fully licensed to complete home studies, counseling, and other processes necessary to complete adoptions for boys and girls in their care. They have completed almost 1,000 adoptions since opening their doors in 1954.

Kids 0-8 in age are decreasing in numbers but kids 12 and older are increasing and needing more care. Two cottages are now home for Foster Care kids. **Jimmy** says they are in critical need of a House Parent couple for a cottage coming on line soon. info@childshome.org

There is now an Assessment Center/shelter, for mostly teens, that are coming to Children’s Home. Kids need to be ‘screened’, or vetted, for proper placement. **Jimmy** and **Luke** mentioned the plans for an Animal Therapeutic Center on campus. Children’s Home has a debt-free modern group care campus, designed to serve 90 children on any given day. Forty-five to sixty more children are served in other programs at the Home and elsewhere in Lubbock.
