Guest Speaker Last Meeting:

Aubrey Spears, Director of Water Utilities, City of Lubbock, was going to bring us a very informative video program about the status of our water supply for Lubbock and Lubbock Co. and the water supply of Wolfforth and subdivisions developed long ago in Lubbock County. However, he decided to just take questions from our club members and discussed what was asked in some detail.

We asked **Aubrey** to come back to allow us to view his detailed video/power-point presentation, that he said would take about 30 minutes, at the Nov. 3rd meeting. He will! **So... be** sure to be here to see this!

Questions asked and answered by Aubrey were basically about the quality, and longevity, of our water supply, and the availability of potable well water in long established housing developments, like Highland Oaks, and others, not connected to Lubbock city water. Aubrey said our water supply is very safe, tho there are chemicals that are being tested for, that can enter our water supply, especially from plastic wastes and chemicals leached into aquifers from businesses, factories, farms, feed lots, military bases, oil wells, septic systems & excreted medicines, TXDoT facilities, yard chemicals/fertilizers. Availability of potable water is assured for decades with Lakes Meredith & Allen Henry and the Roberts & Bailey counties' well fields.

Aubrey mentioned that Lubbock will be developing Lake #7 in the Canyon Lakes project, that will eventually provide water for treatment and placed in our water system. This water is from our waste water treatment plant, as most of the water in Canyon Lakes.
