Guest Speaker Today was:

Dr. Vikram Baliga, Greenhouse Mgr., TTU Horticulture Complex. His wife, Education Director for the Science Spectrum, was a Special Guest! The **Texas Tech University Gardens and Greenhouse Complex** is located north of the United Spirit Arena. This facility provides teaching, research and engagement opportunities for the Department of Plant and Soil Science faculty and students as well as the local community.

Greenhouse construction initiated in 1973 and the complex consists of 8 glass and aluminum greenhouses, a steam drying facility and a plant laboratory with 4 growth chambers, a floral design classroom, and standard laboratory equipment. Two classrooms are outfitted with LCD projectors, Wi-Fi and document cameras to assist in supporting over 1,000 students that attend classes held at the greenhouses each year. The greenhouse complex has 4 research houses with high intensity lighting and automated temperature control to support the estimated \$3,000,000 of research conducted for federal, state and private grants each year. Three teaching greenhouses support the laboratory experiences of students. One greenhouse is for Campus Grounds Maintenance plantings.

The **Horticultural Gardens** started in 1982. The gardens have expanded to include collections of annuals, perennials, shrubs, native plants, roses and a small arboretum. Each of these provide a demonstration area for screening new plant materials for use in semiarid landscapes as well as serving as an outdoor classroom for plant material classes conducted by the **Department of Plant and Soil Science**. The **Gardens** also include a demonstration vineyard, edible and medicinal gardens, and former TTU Pres. Grover Murray's Cactus Collection. The grounds are open from dawn until dusk. Feel free to enjoy a quick lunch on one of the benches or a stroll along the garden's lush paths
