## **Guest Speaker Last Meeting**

Tyler Schuster, Asst Dir. Of Development, Davis College of Ag. Sci. & Nat. Res., Scholarship Program. Tyler brought 3 students who were scholarship recipients: Brook Reyes, Sr. Ag Communication; Madylyn Howell, Jr., Ag Com.; and Lance Nicholas, Jr. Ag Educ. Teacher major. They introduced themselves and told us how much the scholarships meant...

Tyler told us that the J. Raymond Boyd scholarship trust currently has \$541,652. Ray Boyd was a former Kiwanian who had oil royalties that he gave to our club under the stipulation that we transfer the royalties yearly to the Ag scholarship program at Tech. Over the years, the funds were invested by the Tech program, resulting in the current balance.

Tyler said \$261,843 has been dispersed as scholarships to 270 students over the years. 37 students received scholarships totaling \$28,000 this year! That's only \$757 per student, though Tyler said the amounts varied per student. The J. Raymond Boyd Scholarship Program is one of the largest the Ag College has.

During a meeting with **Tyler** and 2 other members of her staff, we asked if the amount of each scholarship could be greater: \$1-2,000, so that it'd have an even greater effect on the student's budget. Wayne told them he received \$500 scholarship in 1974 when he was in the Ag college & inflation would make it worth \$2,000+ today!
