Guest Speaker Last Meeting

. Sherry Sancibrian, Assoc. Chair, Dept. of Speech, Language & Hearing, provided us with updates from programs. Sherry surprised us when she said the Lubbock Kiwanis Clubs have worked with the TTU Speech Clinic since 1932! In 1956, Kiwanis purchased equipment for the Clinic's Child Hearing Tests, to enable clinicians to determine the level of deafness.

Cochlear Implants now have an implant part that is surgically placed underneath the skin & attached to the electrode array that is inserted in the cochlea. This device is used to enable the 'serious to profoundly' deaf person to hear.

Sherry said the Speech Clinic has always helped people with speech impediments, or who have had mouth/tongue injuries that impaired their speech. Medical treatment is available thru UMC, when necessary, and is covered by most insurance policies, Medicare and Medicaid.

Tests for **Respiratory Volume** are also available. A **Stroke Phased Recovery Program**, from brain damage, is free, and available Tuesday mornings.

Summer Camps for Kids with hearing/speech impairment, as well as for adults, now, is conducted for 3 hours every day. Also have the Wee Read Club for 18 mos. to 3 yrs. Parents have access to books Kiwanis members provide for this program. Tech Tykes takes place at the Science Spectrum, and Chatty Champions for 5-9 yr olds with speech issues.
