History of Veterans Day:

WW I – known as "The Great War" – officially ended when the Treaty of Versailles was signed on **June 28, 1919**, in the Palace of Versailles, France. Fighting had ceased 7 months earlier when an armistice, or temporary cessation of hostilities, between Allied nations & Germany went into effect on the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month. For that reason, **Nov. 11, 1918**, is regarded as the end of "the war to end all wars."

In 1926, Pres. Coolidge issued a proclamation calling upon officials to display the flag of the U.S. on Govt. buildings on Nov. 11, inviting citizens to observe the day in schools, churches, or other suitable places, with appropriate ceremonies of friendly relations with all other peoples.

In 1938, Nov. 11th was made a legal holiday - a day to be dedicated to the cause of world peace and to be thereafter celebrated and known as 'Armistice Day', a day set aside to honor Veterans of World War I. In 1954, after WW II & the Korean War (6/50-7/53), the word **Armistice** was replaced with 'Veterans' & Nov. 11th was renamed. In 1968, the Uniform Holiday Bill was signed, celebrating 4 national holidays on Mondays to create 3-day weekends. In 1975, Pres. Ford returned the observance of Veterans Day to Nov. 11th, beginning in 1978! This action supported the desires of nearly all state legislatures, all veterans service organizations & the American people.
