Briseno, DPS Spokesmen, History
& Updates from Dept. of Public Safety.
Lt. Bures told us that:

**1823** – Stephen F. Austin, the 'Father of Texas' formed the Texas Rangers, 10 men, to act as 'rangers' to protect 600-700 newly settled families who arrived in Mexican Texas following the Mexican War of Independence.

1927 – State Hwy Dept. formed1929 – State Hwy Patrol formed

**1935** – TX Rangers/State Fire Marshals merged w/State Hwy Patrol.

**2011** – Started 'Human Trafficking' program; TX is 1<sup>st</sup> state in the nation to make sex buying a felony. Since than 600+ kids were saved from abduction!

2016 – 30,000+ people trained for human trafficking since this date.
2019 – TX creates the Texas Human Trafficking Prevention Coordinating Council to eradicate human trafficking.

Sgt. Briseno said victims of DWI crashes are now eligible for monetary help. Biggest changes have been technological. Body cams, in-car cameras, tasers w/10 shots, 30 boats, from gun boats to shallow skiffs. Dive teams for evidence & body recoveries. Canine Patrols for narcotic detecting/trafficking (no 'bite' (attack) dogs! Aircraft Division with fixed wing, helicopters/drones!

New Bronco/Humvee patrol vehicles with 'ballistic' glass and door panels. Special Response Teams now under TX Rangers, for civil disturbances. DPS does not enforce any immigration laws.

#### Are you ever on 'Cloud Nine'?

So... what inspired the idiom "on cloud nine? Well, there are some similar mid-20th-century idiomatic examples combining clouds with numbers. One of the earliest instances appears in Albin Pollock's 1935 slang dictionary *The Underworld Speaks*, which reads, "Cloud eight, befuddled on account of drinking too much liquor."

By 1960, "cloud seven" implied happiness — the Online Etymology Dictionary suggests a potential connection to the idyllic "seventh heaven." A reference appeared in *The Dictionary of American Slang*: "Cloud seven — completely happy, perfectly satisfied; in a euphoric state."

While many types of clouds evoke a

dreamlike, euphoric state, "cloud nine" eventually became more popular than "cloud seven" and "cloud eight," and we might find the answer as to why in pop music. "Cloud Nine" was a popular 1968 Temptations song, earning Motown Records its first Grammy. Almost 20 years later, in 1987, former Beatle George Harrison released an album titled Cloud Nine. It's fair to assume people are more likely to remember these musical references
